

## Oaxacan photographer to visit Dutchess County

Eric Mindling, a prize-winning photographer from Santa Fe, will visit Dutchess County in July to discuss his experiences documenting the disappearing way of life of Oaxacan villagers. His workshops are part of Oaxaca Week 2023 that celebrates the heritage and culture of this part of Mexico. His photographs will be exhibited in Poughkeepsie and Red Hook.

Mindling spent 25 years in Oaxaca learning the stories and traditions of its indigenous peoples and writing a book about his experiences “Oaxaca Stories in Cloth”. The book will be available for sale at the workshops.
